
- The population of people in iceland is about 339,817 people

- Has been isolated in Iceland for more than 1000 years.








- Iceland is the first country in the world to have a female president, Vigdís Finnbogadóttir, and a openly gay prime minister, Jóhanna Sigurðardóttir

- Skagafjörður is a fjord in northern Iceland, between Tröllaskagi and Skagi.
- In Skagafjörður there is a little town called Hólar and in 1106 there was built an episcopal and it was used for the next 7. Centuries.
- Our saga in Skagafjörður has been shaped by the episcopal in Hólar as a lot of great men have built their estate.

- In Iceland the sheeps and horses are out in the meadows. In september they are gathered together in a herd and the farmers go and pick out the sheeps and horses that they own and take them back home.
- In Skagafjörður there is a horse herding called Laufskálarétt. It is one of the biggest herdings in Iceland. This takes place in September with a big party after to celebrate.




